We were pleased this month that after several delays we were able to place two batches of broilers. Second years Edgar and Robson are taking responsibility for these batches and they have shown incredible commitment to the task. Their hard work is already resulting in the birds achieving good weights and a low mortality.

Second years Florence and Youngson have equally been showing a lot of commitment in cropping this month. With help from first years, they have been growing cabbage, onion and green pepper.

We have seen considerable progress in our layer barn, in which we plan to place 4,000 birds. By the end of July, cages were in place with manure removal belts as well and apprentices are excited to start farming layers in the next month!
