Our layer hens are now in their 52nd week of production and they are achieving a lay rate of 87%.

In March, we transplanted 1 ha of cabbage, ½ ha of tomato and ¼ ha of onion.



For a while we have been wanting to scale-up our small-scale broiler production to the point of placing birds weekly rather than bi-weekly. With good progress so far, we made this transition this month. We continue to be impressed by the high standards our apprentices are showing in stewardship.

Domingos Dias Vincente is a second-year apprentice who's love for God is noticeable every day. It is nice to see his dedication and humility in all the tasks that are entrusted to him. He has especially served as a great help in managing our irrigation system. It is rare for us to 24-hours of electricity each day, and Domingos does not mind waking up even at night to turn on the generator to ensure our system remains operational. As he nears the end of his 2 years with us, we ask for your prayers for him, that he may continue in his brilliance, spirit of readiness and above all his devotion to the Lord in the face of challenges.
