In May we harvested ¼ hectare of tomato and 1 hectare of corn which is currently in the process of being threshed. We also transplanted ½ hectare each of onion and cabbage.

Our layer birds reached 57 weeks by the end of May, with a lay-rate of 92% which is positive and encouraging.

Our weekly broiler placements are keeping apprentices busy and it is great to see how much they learning about broiler production; when we visit the aviaries, it is now common to hear them discussing how crucial the first 7 days of a chick's life are for achieving good results at the end of the batch!
